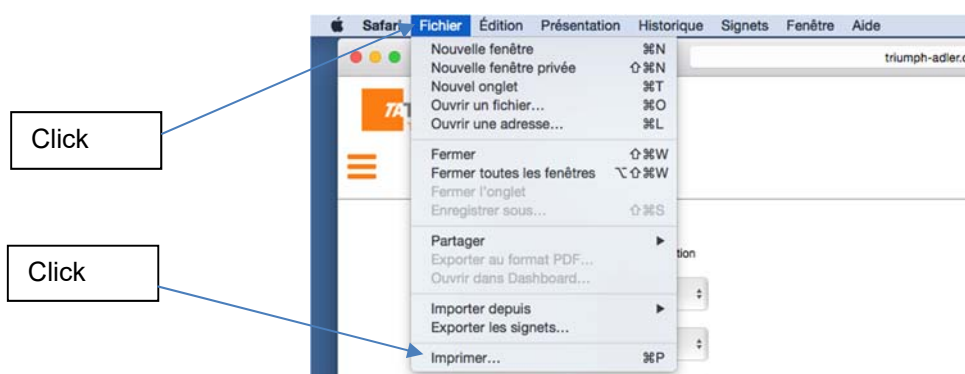
Subject: Setting a printer's default options in Mac OS. Models :All systems

Principle : Configure printing options to store a number of settings, such as using Account ID or Black & White printing.

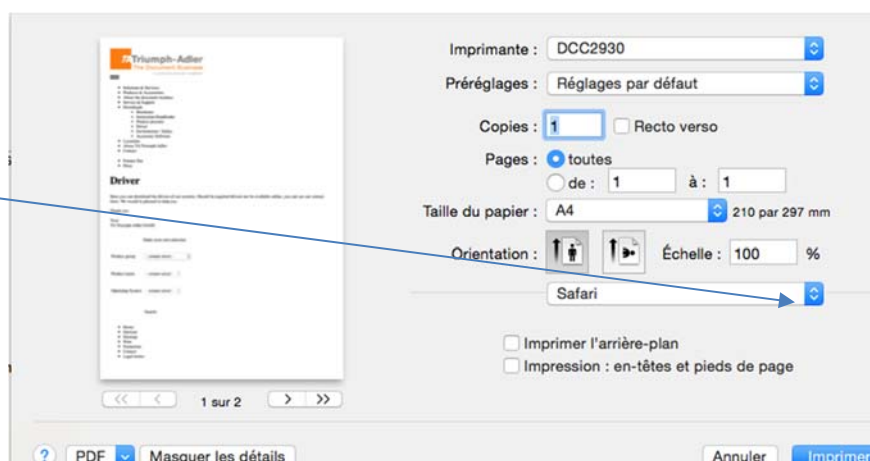
Note : Unlike Windows, the default print options are not in the system preferences, but directly in the applications itself.

1 Setting the parameters.

Once the printer is correctly installed, you must run any application (Word, Excel, Safari ...) to configure the default options for this printer. The easiest way is to launch the "Safari" web browser



Then click on the drop-down menu below ...

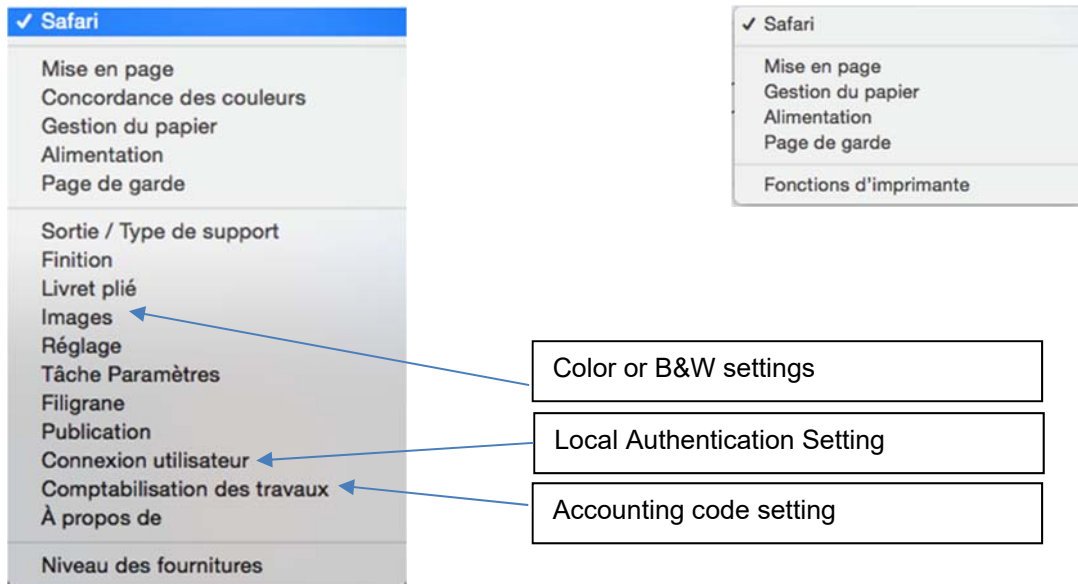


2 Drop-down menu.

Depending on the printer driver (PPD) installed, the drop-down menu is as follows:

Triumph-Adler Printer Driver (KPDL)

Print Driver Generic Mac.



3 Saving settings.

Once the configurations have been made, they can be named and saved
